LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES FOR FY24



1. Securing a legislative resolution to RVP/year-round E15.
2. Continue seeking opportunities for high octane, low carbon fuels policies such as the Next Generation Fuels Act and national clean fuels standard policies.
3. Seek additional focus on biofuels and bio-based products by reauthorizing the Farm Bill.
4. Re-establish the R&D Tax Credit by passing S. 866 and H.R. 2673.
5. Continue to enhance ethanol's opportunities in sustainable aviation fuel through fair modeling treatment and consistent statutory definitions.
6. Protect and defend RFS against legislative attacks.
